There are 270 World Trade Centers in over 90 countries. The association boasts over 750,000 members worldwide.

Formerly the Southcentral Pennsylvania International Network, the organization invested in the region and our globally competitive companies and became a member of the World Trade Centers Association. Because of this affiliation, Southcentral Pennsylvania and the 3700 manufacturing facilities located in this region are positioned as a global powerhouse to the rest of the world.

These world-wide privileges include meeting and club facilities, trade information and education services, exhibit space, access to temporary office space, video-conferencing facilities, secretarial and translation services.
